Scrap Metal Dealers Act 1964

You have been duly registered as a Scrap Metal Dealer under the above Act and in respect of the premises stated in your application form. Such registration will be in force for a period of three years expiring on the 17th March 2014

Your Registration Number is: LN/000000010

The Act imposes a number of duties on scrap metal dealers and you should make yourself familiar with the requirements. For your information, I enclose a copy of a leaflet which you should read and keep by you as a reminder.

The Council have asked me to point out that this registration does not convey any rights under the Planning Acts to use the land and premises for the purpose of scrap metal dealing. Under Section 12 of the Planning Act 'development' includes making of any material change in the use of any buildings or other land and you should therefore ascertain whether planning permission is required for the use of your premises or land for scrap metal dealing and, if so, make formal application for the prescribed forms, obtained from these offices. The Council's Officers are available to advise you on the Planning Acts, Regulations, etc, if desired.

You should also be aware that under the Control of Pollution(Amendment) Act 1989, as a registered scrap metal dealer, you will be required to register as a carrier of controlled waste. The Environment Agency is the Waste Regulation Authority for East Sussex and should be contacted for further information.
